CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Go to The Business School UK's Virtual Learning Environment (VLE):

On the navigation menu at the top of the page, click **Log in** (top right).

On the Log in page create a new account by clicking the **Create new account** button (bottom right).

You are required to choose a Username and Password and then provide the following information:

- Email address (use the email address you wish to be contact with from the VLE and The Business School UK)
- First name
- Surname

You are also required to agree to the site policy agreement by ticking the box provided.

Click **Create my new account**.

You will receive a confirmation email from the VLE asking you to confirm the account. You need to click on the link in the email to do this.

SELF -ENROL

Military students are able to self-enrol on military courses using a code provided by their course instructor.
